An estate admission fee of £2.50 per vehicle, payable to Gregynog, will apply during the day, but not for evening concerts. The nearest bus and railway stations are in Newtown, where taxis are available.

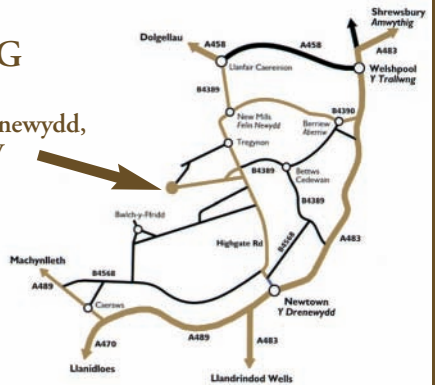
