## MINUTE 4 F/20 – FINANCIAL FORECAST

• Cllr Mills explained how the financial forecast reflected the annual projection.

Cllr Weston advised that  $\pounds 5K$  had been included in the precept with a further  $\pounds 6K$  from earmarked funds, totalling  $\pounds 11K$  budgeted. Cllr Weston advised in relation to the Town Hall repayments budget line that the  $\pounds 5K$  shown was the amount called for in the precept only and the earmarked funds were intended to be used in addition to cover the repayments for the year.

- It was proposed to spend £600 from the cleaning budget to pay for VAT review
- Dowry for MCBPT had been included in considerations when the contingency against transfer was estimated/calculated in the budget.
- It would potentially cost £455per month to re-open toilets if they were cleaned once per day. A sanitising dispenser would be required plus liquid.
- Cllr Mills recommended that £100 from VE Day budget be given to Taste Montgomery for VJ Day. This will be on the full council agenda
- Cllr Mills suggested a honorarium for the upkeep of the Memorial Garden of £75 which will be taken from Memorial Garden bank account.
